**Early Years – Nursery and Reception Home Learning Expectations.**

# Letter



- Letter re home learning sent to all parents yesterday (Tuesday).
- All learning will be uploaded onto Teams. Anyone without their Teams login please email and this will be organised. Nursery logins to be sent out tomorrow (Thursday).
- There will be login times at the same time each day – apart from Friday. This is to build consistency and build good habits.
- Both online and offline learning to be completed.

# Online and offline learning:



- Reception login times are: 10 am and 2.30 pm Monday to Thursday and Friday 09.30am.
- Reception children will be invited to small group work sessions on Teams in the next few weeks – phonics, sentence work, funky fingers, reading.
- Nursery login time is 2pm Monday to Thursday and Friday 09.30am.
- Offline learning is on the grids - these are in the pack and on Teams. Both Nursery and Reception learning is expected to be completed as it links in with phonics and the online sessions with teachers. Tick when done.

# Offline learning:



- Reading with an adult daily for 10 minutes. Books are in their learning packs.
- Reception: the login for MyOn is on the front of the home learning envelope you will get on Friday.
- There will be a weekly upload of phonics sessions with one session to be completed daily. Just click on the link for that day.

## In addition:



- Children need to have a regular daily routine.
- Please tick off the activities on your learning grid as you have completed them.
- You can repeat activities – repetition is important for practise.

# How you can best support the school in keeping our virtual classrooms safe places of learning

- Your child must take part in a suitable environment – not a bedroom
- Let household members know that a live lesson is taking place *so they can make sure they are suitably dressed and use appropriate language and behaviour when nearby or in the background.*
- End of a live lesson can parent/carers make sure their child has logged off correctly

# Importance

- Screenshots, photos or recordings of lessons must not be made.
- Lessons will be recorded for those not able to attend due to siblings sharing devices but these must not be shared with others.





# Learning pack:

You won't need lots of resources and toys – all activities can be carried out with things you have in the home!

Use socks, cutlery, pasta, spoons, make playdough, use water and containers and pots, make marks in salt– in fact anything!
