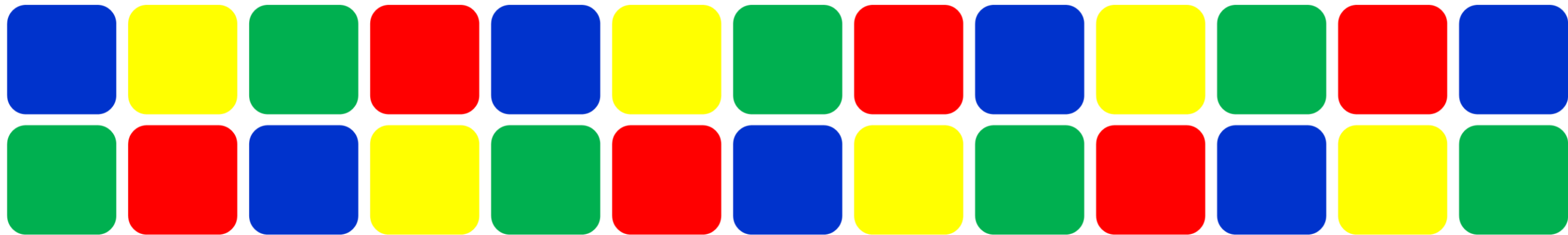

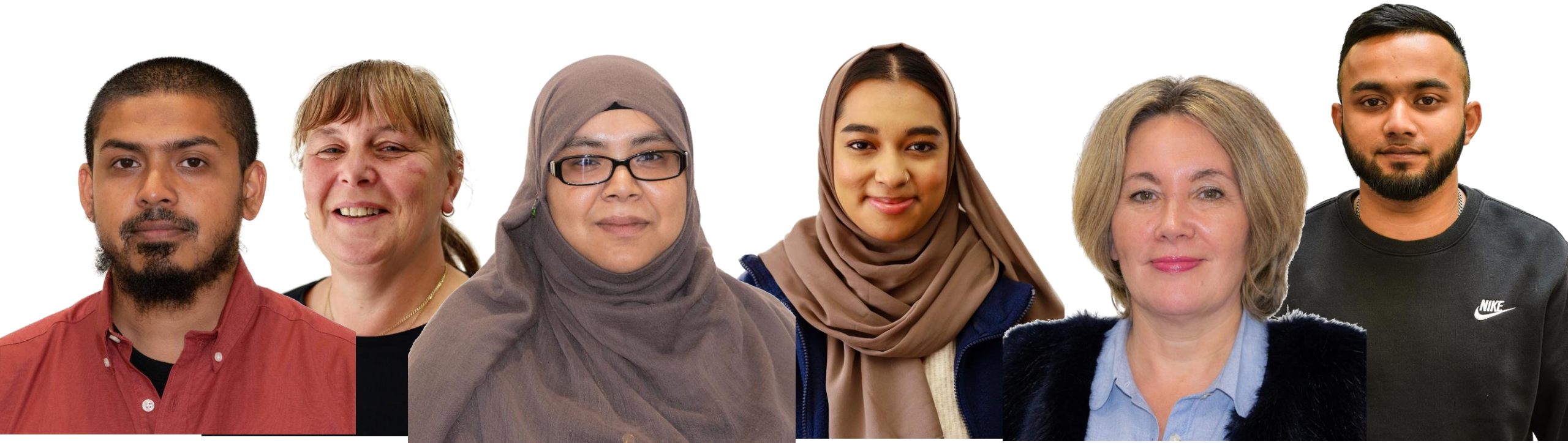

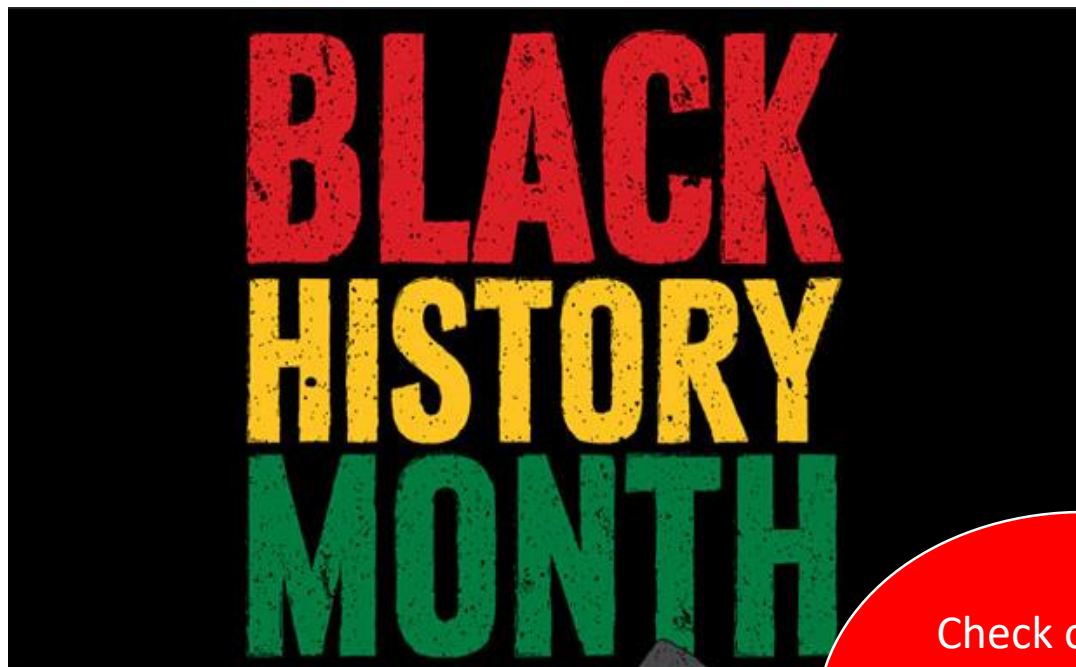


Attendance and Punctuality

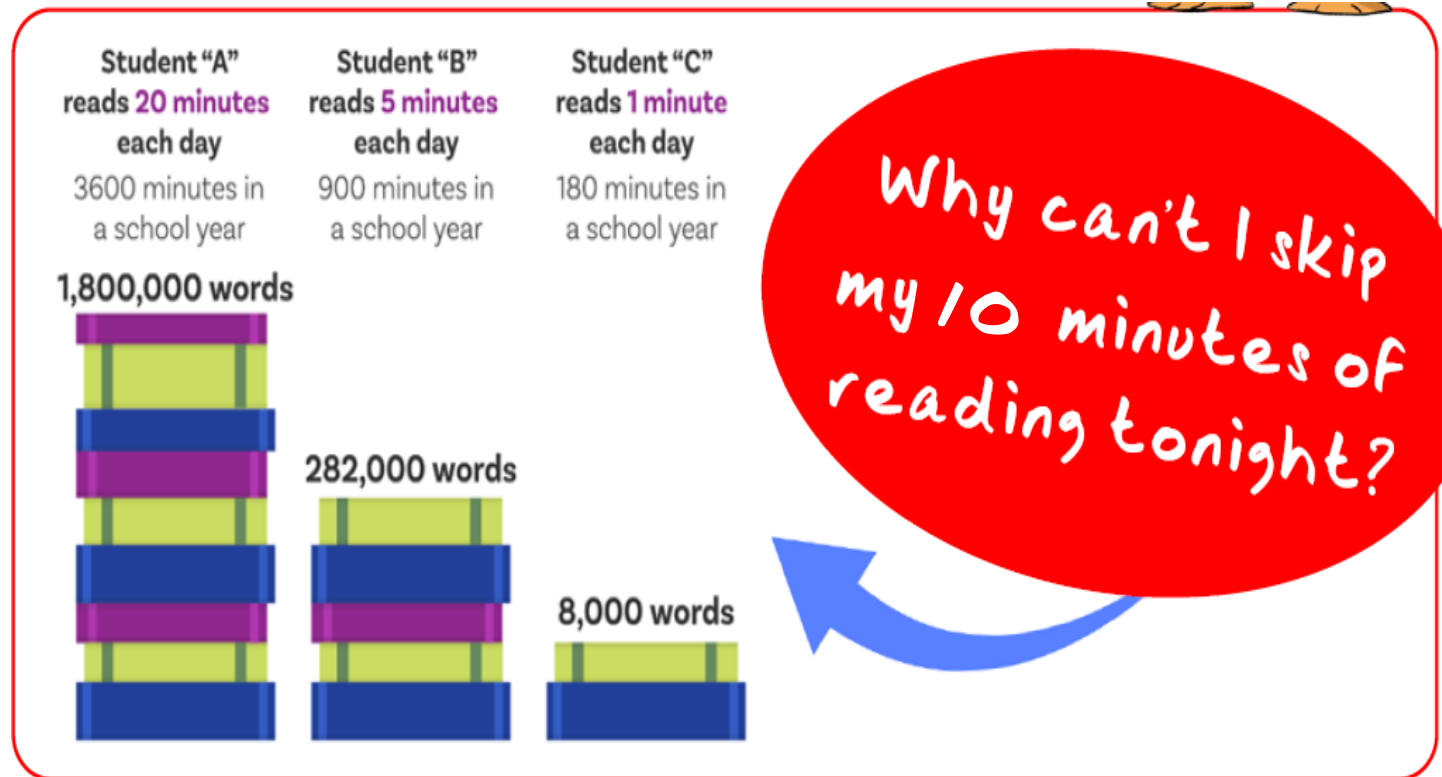

- Giving change

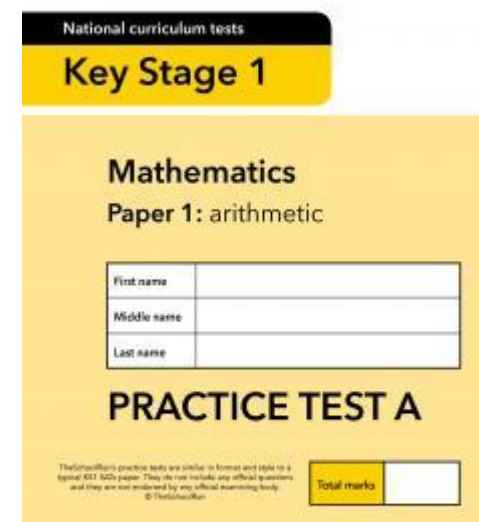
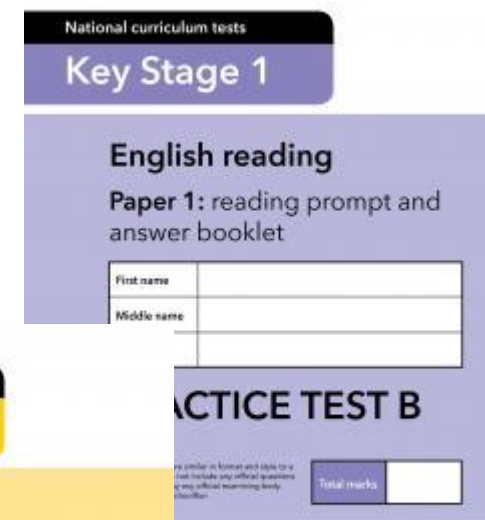

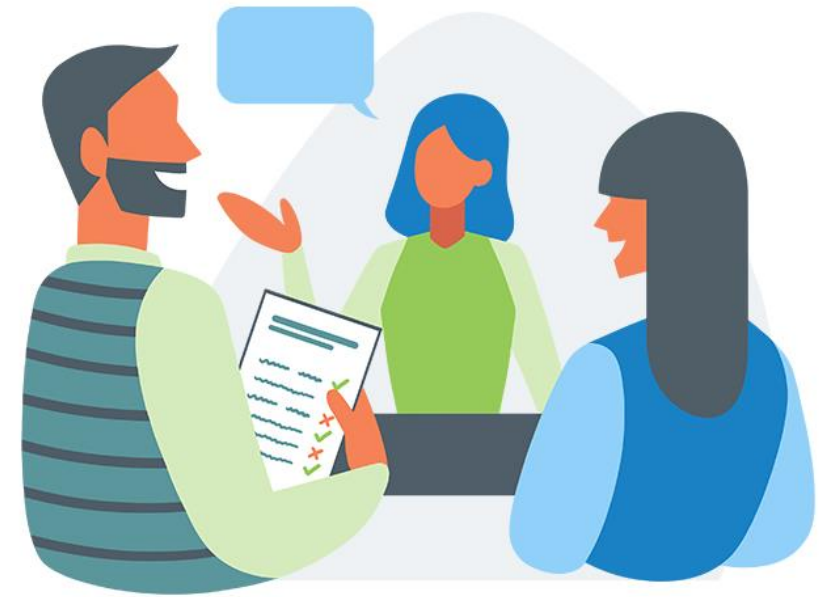

Learning Celebration will be on Wednesday the 19th in the afternoon.



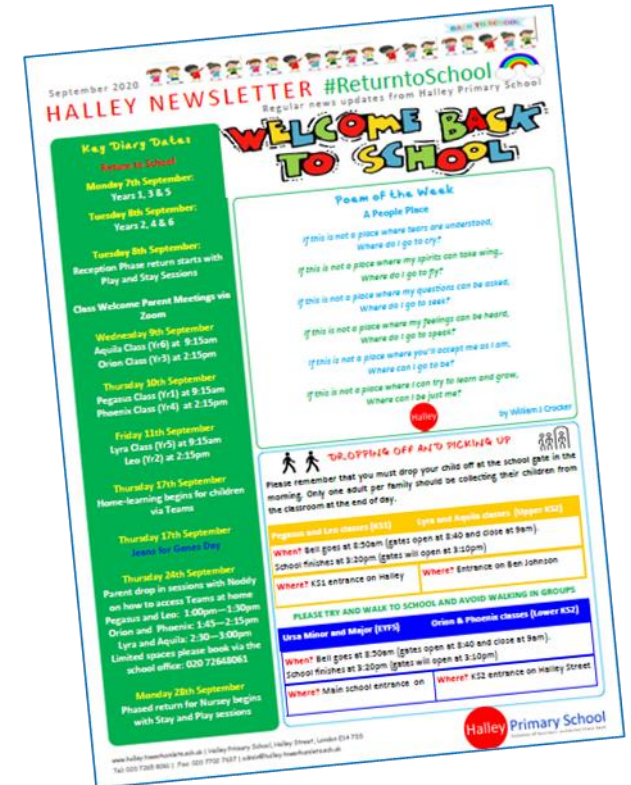
